

## Peter Moser: CV

Peter Moser is a graduate (PhD.) from the University of Bern. After completing an apprenticeship he has studied Contemporary History, German Literature and Economics in Bern, Dublin and Galway. He is the founder (2002) and since then director of the Archives of Rural History (AHR) in Bern, a scientific institution engaged in historical research as well as archiving sources ([www.histoiredurale.ch](http://www.histoiredurale.ch)).

Peter Moser is an associate researcher at the Department of Social, Economic and Environmental History at the Institute of History at the University of Bern. In 2013 he was visiting professor at the Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales (EHESS) in Paris and chairman of the scientific committee of the international conference *Rural History 2013* in Bern, which was organised by the Archives of Rural History. Since 2017 he is Co-editor of the *Jahrbuch für Geschichte des ländlichen Raumes – Rural History Yearbook* in Austria. From 2009-2019 he was Chairman of the *Swiss Rural History Society* (SRHS). Since 2010 he acts as Treasurer and member of the Management Committee of the *European Rural History Organisation* (EURHO) ([www.ruralhistory.eu](http://www.ruralhistory.eu)) and since 2017 he is President of the European Rural History Film Association ([www.ruralfilms.eu](http://www.ruralfilms.eu)).

Peter Moser is currently leading two SNF-funded research projects a) *Languages of Agricultural and Industrial Work: Knowledge, metaphors of production and the Transformation of Work 1880-1960* (SNF-Nr. 100011\_169566, duration 2017-2021) and, b) *Kulturen und Raumordnungen der Arbeitstiere. Grundlagen zu einer Geschichte der tierlichen Trag- und Zugarbeit* (SNF-Nr. 100012\_189000, duration 2020-2022).
